## DAY 01

**Arrive at Kolkata airport -** The 'City of Joy' the most apt place for the eager visitants, the places of interest in Kolkata are numerous. This eventful city with its many marvels has truly a lot to offer. Since its birth, it has metamorphosed into one of the most sought after destinations for the tourists from all over the globe. Today it's known for its grand colonial architecture, art galleries and cultural festivals. Meet and assistance on arrival and transfer to the hotel.

Later, you have the option of proceeding for half day city tour visiting - **St Paul's Cathedral Church** – a - Anglican Cathedral in Kolkata, noted for its Gothic architecture . Also visit **Victoria Memorial** - a large marble building built between 1906 and 1921. The memorial was built to serve a dual purpose - to mark the success of the British Empire in India, and as a memorial to Queen Victoria.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Kolkata.

## DAY 02

### Golf at the Royal Calcutta Golf Club

The Royal Calcutta Golf Club (or the Royal as it is affectionately called), is the oldest golf club in India, and the oldest golf club outside of the British Isles. Founded in 1829, the club was honoured by King George V and Queen Mary with the title of Royal in 1911 to commemorate their visit to Calcutta.

The course today is a 18 hole, 6978 yards par 72, is a challenging course and rewards accuracy while punishing wayward shots!

The All India Amateur Golf Championship is the 2<sup>nd</sup> oldest running golf tournament in the world after the British Open and was actually a RCGC event started in 1892.

After you have enjoyed Golf you have the option of exploring Kolkata a little more by visiting the various sites

**Indian Museum (Closed on Monday's and National Holidays)** – is the largest and oldest museum in India and has rare collections of antiques, armor and ornaments, fossils, skeletons, mummies, and Mughal paintings

**Mother House (Closed on Thursday's and National Holidays)** –The **Missionaries of Charity's Mother House** is a holy place of pilgrimage and reverence for those who are searching for a more meaningful existence.

Overnight stay at the hotel in Kolkata.

### DAY 03

#### Golf at Tollygunge Golf Club

Founded in 1895, the Tollygunge Golf Club is spread over a 100 acres and has a club house that is almost 200 years old. It is a 18 hole, 6304 yard par 70 layout. It has a number of water hazards with tree lined fairways and small greens calling for accurate iron play.

After Golf you could explore the rest of Kolkata visiting the **Botanical Garden (Closed on Mondays and National Holidays)** – are situated 8 kms away from the city, on the west bank of the Ganga, covering an area of about 273 acres. Laid out in the year 1787, Calcutta botanical garden is one of the oldest and largest botanical gardens of India

**Kalighat Kali Temple** –is regarded as the holiest peeth or pith of the 52 Shakti Peethams of India, where the various parts of Sati's body are said to have fallen, in the course of Shiva's RudraTandava. Kalighat represents the site where the toes of the right foot of Shakti or Sati fell. Overnight stay at the Hotel in Kolkata.
